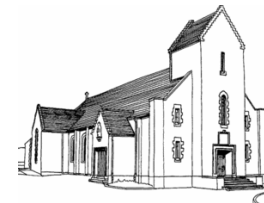

NEW @ St Marg.	<p>St Margaret's Fabric Committee Announcement:</p> <p>A new confessional has now been installed in the Church and after a few finishing touches it will be ready to be used, providing a better environment to celebrate Reconciliation.</p> <p>Following 2 failed attempts for funding to support major works, the Archdiocese has given permission to proceed and the FC will meet with the Architect & Quantity Surveyor on Tuesday.
