An Invitation to Believe (Chapel Royal, Falkland KY15 BU) at 7pm

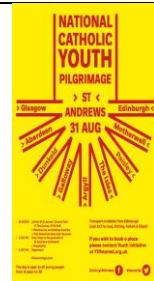
