**Parish Building and Maintenance Fund Collection in St Margaret's**

The first valuation for work carried out on the Legacy Project has been received and amounts for £27,572.49 (exc. VAT). We have already paid our £25,040.88 in professional fees and to increase our insurance for the contract period.
