Ahead of the action in our Churches in October, the General Secretariat for the Synod has published the **Preparatory Document**, along with a **Vademecum** (or handbook) to indicate the guiding principles that will direct the path of the Synod on Synodality.

It is intended to facilitate the first phase of listening and consultation of the People of God in the particular Churches, which will take place from October 2021 to April 2022.

The preparatory document indicates ten ways that “articulate different facets of ‘lived synodality’”:

- \* *The Journeying Companions*
- \* *Listening*
- \* *Speaking Out*
- \* *Celebrating*
- \* *Co-responsible in the Mission*
- \* *Dialogue in Church and Society*
- \* *With the Other Christian Denominations*
- \* *Authority and Participation*
- \* *Discerning and Deciding*
- \* *Forming Ourselves in Synodality*

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions. Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.
