Ahead of the action in our Churches, the General Secretariat for the Synod has published the **Preparatory Document**, along with a **Vademecum** (or handbook) to indicate the guiding principles that will direct the path of the Synod on Synodality.

From the preparatory document, this week we look at the **fifth** of the themes involved in this journey as first we journey together with one another as the People of God and next as we journey together as the People of God with the entire human family.

V. CO-RESPONSIBLE IN THE MISSION

Synodality is at the service of the Church's mission, in which all her members are called to participate.

Since we are all missionary disciples, how is each Baptized person called to be a protagonist in the mission? How does the community support its members committed to service in society (social and political commitment, in scientific research and teaching, in the promotion of social justice, in the protection of human rights, and in caring for the Common home, etc.)? How do you help them to live out these commitments in a logic of mission?
