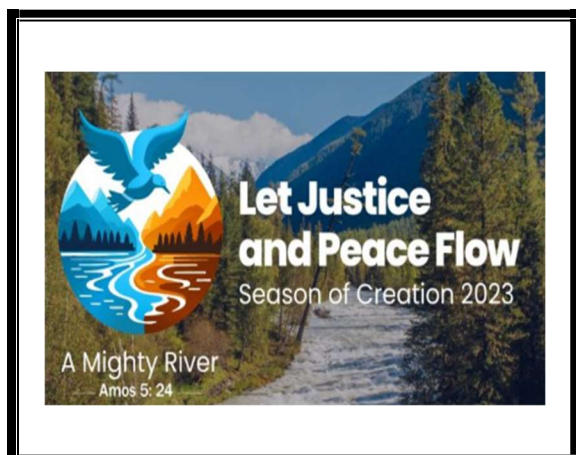

BOARD OF REMEMBRANCE

The Church holds a stock of blank brass plates, to ensure uniformity.

If you wish a plaque engraved and mounted on the Board of Remembrance in the garden at the front of the Church, please contact Mike Pendlowski with the wording of your choice via 07525 920728 or mike@pendlowski.plus.com.

Plaques usually take 2 - 3 days from first contact to mounting, plus they are given two coats of brass lacquer to negate the need for future polishing.
