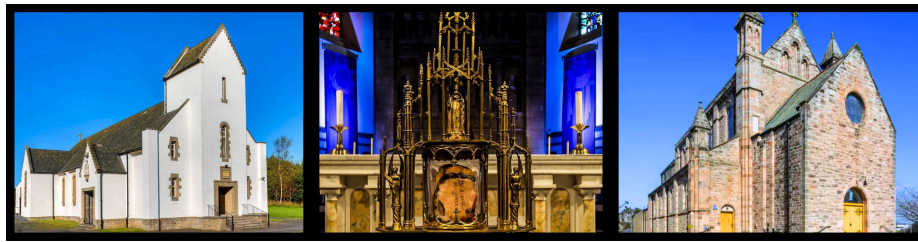

Car Parking barrier – St Margaret's

We apologise for the malfunctioning of the car park barrier at St Margaret's last Sunday. Unfortunately there are many more cars at the 9.30 Mass than there are parking spaces. If the "Car Park Full" sign is displayed, all the spaces are occupied but it is still possible to drop off at the front door before seeking a space in the Viewfield Car Park. It would be helpful if drivers who are fit and able use the Viewfield car park thus leaving spaces for older parishioners and those with mobility issues.

Please remember that the area in front of the main door has to be kept clear to enable drop-offs and access for emergency vehicles. This area is a No Parking Zone.

ST. MARGARET'S PARISH REGISTER



Dear Friends in Christ,

It's one year since we launched the Parish Register Project. I am confident that this will serve as an important document to help us to have a better understanding about our parish. I firmly believe that it will enable us to see the wider picture of our faith community by serving as an essential document for future planning through effective communication and competent administration. 480 parishioners have registered in the 1st year.

From 1st of August onwards, we started using this document as the primary source of evidence to prove the membership status of the parishioners especially when it becomes a concern in the context of issuing weddings, baptisms, testimonial letters, certificates, approval forms etc.

Additionally, we have made use of the register on several occasions throughout the year to keep parishioners updated. And in December, it was most valuable to communicate in an emergency that Holy Name was closed due to the heating breaking down.

We have a few individuals who haven't yet registered either due to their own personal reasons or by the habit of procrastination. To this end, the QR code and other essential guidelines for registration can be found below.

If you have any technical challenges in registering, please call the Parish Office and, with your permission, we can add your details on your behalf.

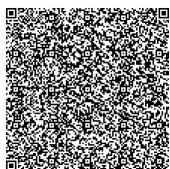

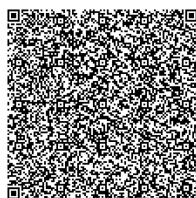

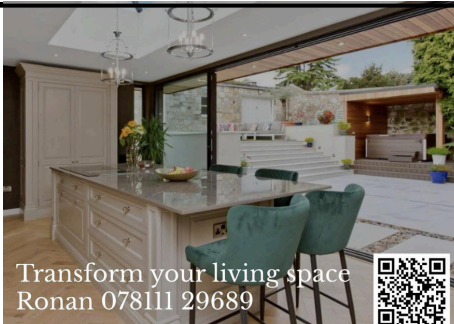

SCRIPTUREREADINGS

3RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME – YEAR (A)



FIRST READING Isaiah 9:1b–4

In the former time the Lord brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the latter time he has made glorious the way of the sea, the land beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations. The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone. You have multiplied the nation; you have increased its joy; they rejoice before you as with joy at the harvest, as they are glad when they divide the spoil. For the yoke of his burden, and the staff for his shoulder, the rod of his oppressor, you have broken as on the day of Midian.

SECOND READING 1 Corinthians 1:10–13, 17

I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgement. For it has been reported to me by Chloe's people that there is quarrelling among you, my brothers and sisters. What I mean is that each one of you says, 'I follow Paul', or 'I follow Apollos', or 'I follow Cephas', or 'I follow Christ.' Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptised in the name of Paul? For Christ did not send me to baptise but to preach the gospel, and not with words of eloquent wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.

GOSPEL Matthew 4:12–17

When Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew into Galilee. And leaving Nazareth he went and lived in Capernaum by the sea, in the territory of Zebulun and Naphtali, so that what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled: 'The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles – the people dwelling in darkness have seen a great light, and for those dwelling in the region and shadow of death, on them a light has dawned.' From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.'
